



Axon cameras in lockup interview room

Hi All,

Axon has installed new cameras in the lockup interview room. The room has three cameras, two that are stationary and one that is a pan/tilt/zoom. If you have an arrestee that needs to be audio and video recorded, please put them in the lockup interview room. The camera is controlled by a tablet that is located near the computer that is facing the group holding cell.

To login to the tablet and start recording, enter your Evidence.com user name, no password needed, follow the prompts which will get you to the screen with blue create recording button at the bottom. Press the create recording button which will take you to a screen with a red button that says "start recording", press that button and your recording will begin. The system prerecords both audio and video for 30 seconds prior to pressing the start recording button.

Once your recording is complete, press stop recording, you will then have the opportunity to enter specifics about the case such as case number and type of case. The recording will automatically be uploaded to your Evidence.com folder.
